## HEADY SCRAP BOOK

This scrap book, dated 25 Dec 1886, was kept by Sarah E. Baker Heady. She was a great-aunt of the present owner, Esthermay Goldizen, Box 201, Fremont, Ia. 52561. Scrap books can be a source of genealogical information, especially if organized in a manner so that names can be easily found. Too often scrap books are discarded upon the demise of the owner. We believe Mrs. Heady's book merits publication to illustrate what a scrap book might contain and because most of the individuals in it have an Iowa connection.

- Bennett, Laura Ellen Herring b 14 Mar 1865 d 31 Jul 1902 dau/o William and Emsaline Herring, m George A. Bennett 14 Aug 1888, 1 dau, Gladys.
- Buchanan, Sarah A. Heady b 1852 d Feb 1925, 2 daus, Clara Buchanan of Floris and Mrs Evan Hudgens of Ottumwa. 3 sons, Frank, Warren and Curtis. 2 sisters, Mrs Mary Gibbs, Mrs Ollie Baker and 4 bros, Tom, Frank, Lawrence and Dean Heady. Buried at Chequest Cemetery.
- Conner, Elizabeth Wheatly b 25 May 1855 in Coshocton Co., Oh. d 16 Sep 1897, dau/o H. S. and Mary Wheatley, moved to Iowa with them & settled in Lee Co; m J. A. Conner 14 Mar 1877.
- Eberline, Melcenis A. d 27 May 1903 at Belknap, Ia., wf/o Fredrick Eberline.
- Emanuel, Gertrude Daisy Harter b 1 Jun 1877 at Floris, Ia. d 18 Oct 1923, m Aaron Emanuel 7 Sep 1895, they had 6 ch: Mrs Ernest Pence, Harold, Charles, Donald, Bernard and Verlin. 1 bro, J. C. Harter.
- Everly, Rev. H. J. d Nov 1923 at Knox City, Mo. Buried at Jefferson, Ia.
- Fenton, Roy d 7 Apr 1881, youngest son/o Mr & Mrs F. M. Fenton.
- Galpin, Mrs Henry d 9 May 1903 dau/o Harvey Conner, m Henry Galpin, s/o George N.
- Harter, Charles Albert b 19 Sep 1847 Jefferson Co., N.Y., res/o Davis Co. Ia. since 1874. Apr 1861, he enlisted under Capt Merriman of 3rd N.Y. Light Artillery, age 13 yrs. 24 Mar 1864, age 16 yrs, he enlisted in Co. K. 10th N.Y. Heavy Artly. m 5 Jan 1870 Sarah Amanda Hull of Lewis Co., N.Y. She d 16 Nov 1913. They had two ch: Jesse C., and Gertrude D. Emanuel. m Mrs. Ida A. Carmichael 3 Jun 1914.
- Harter, Sarah Amanda Hull b 2 Aug 1852 Jefferson Co, N.Y. d 16 Nov 1913 at Bloomfield, Ia., m 5 Jan 1870 Charles Albert Harter. One bro, A. D. Hull, one sister Mrs Julia C. Potter, both of Scott Co., Kan.
- Heady, Lawrence Curtis b 24 Jul 1865 at Vevay, Ind. d 21 Oct 1926 Bloomfield, Ia., moved to Floris, Ia when 21 yrs of age. M Ida Honor Dearborn 9 Oct 1890. They had 4 daus: Mrs Ethel Hart, Elsie Elizabeth who d in infancy, Mrs Florence Mathiason, and Mabel Heady.
- Heady, Richard Franklin b 17 Apr 1854 Switzerland Co., Ind. d 10 Nov 1925 Omaha, Nebr. m 15 Oct 1873 Rebecca Ann Murdock. They had two sons: Merl F. and Orel C. At age 28, he moved to Floris, Ia., later moving to Chase Co., Nebr. His wife d 7 Aug 1904. On 4 Sep 1905 he m. Sarah E. Baker of Bloomfield, Ia. He had three bros: L. C., T. L., and F. D. Heady, two sis: Mrs Mary Gibbs & Mrs Olive Baker.
- Heady, Thomas Franklin b 21 Jul 1862 Floris, Ia. d 7 Jul 1925 Mt. Pleasant, Ia., m Mattie Thompson 22 May 1889. They had two ch: Eugene and Ruth.

- Herring, Montie b 2 Dec 1873 Kellogg Twp. d Sep 1889, one bro. Albert.
- Hull, Arthur Duane b 30 Jan 1850 Antwerp, N.Y. d 27 May 1933, m Louise Pierson  
12 Jun 1872. 1873 left N.Y. & moved to Kan. After living in Scott Co., Kan for  
11 years, moved to Iowa. Had six sons: C.A., L. J., Frank, Spencer, Arthur and  
Walter E. Two daus: Mrs H. S. Rector and Mrs R. O. Stanley.
- Hull, Jesse b 21 Jun 1819 Jefferson Co., N.Y. d 2 Oct 1907 Bloomfield, Ia. m 29  
Nov 1840 Sophia Randall who d 24 May 1879. They had five ch: Adelia, William,  
Julia, Duain, and Sarah. m 2nd Mildred Aldridge 6 Jan 1883. Served 3 yrs in Co.  
P. 5th NY Artillery. To Davis Co., Ia. 1873. Buried at Dunnville, Ia.
- Kinman, Norman Parks b 29 Apr 1852 at New Hartford, Ill., d 3 Jul 1919 near  
Dunnville, Ia. Came to Iowa with parents when quite young. m Hattie Sutton Aug  
1873. They had 5 ch: m 2nd Leyda Baker 12 Oct 1908. Buried at Dunnville, Iowa.
- Kneedler, Mrs Ellen Feagins b 1825 Ohio, d 22 Jun 1899, m 1844 G. W. Kneedler.  
They had four children.
- Peden, Arthur B. b 1 May 1870 Davis Co., Ia. d 16 Feb 1925 in Oakland, Nebr. m  
Emma Hayes 24 Jun 1890. They had 3 ch: Arthur Howard, Frank E. & Fern W.  
Adopted a dau, Lois, in 1919 at age 3 yrs. One bro, Orrin Peden.
- Peden, Joseph b 14 Apr 1823 Gallia Co., Oh, d 8 Jul 1900 at Floris, Ia. Came to  
Iowa 1843, one of the earliest settlers in Lick Creek Twp. On 1 Dec 1850 m  
Mary J. Morgan and they had seven children.
- Peden, Joseph b 6 Jul 1844 Ohio, d 28 Dec 1909 in Davis Co., came to Iowa 1849.  
m Martha Strickland 23 Sep 1869. They had 6 ch. Served 2½ yrs Co. E. 36th Ia. Inf  
Vol. Civil War.
- Peden, Orrin b 30 Nov 1854 d 10 Sep 1927 at Mark, Ia. m 29 Feb 1880 Anna E. Bell.  
They had five children.
- Shelton, Cora b 1871 d 1888 at Bloomfield, Ia.. dau/o Milton Shelton.
- Shelton, Dr. E. J. b 20 Oct 1831 in Decatur Co., Ind. d 18 Feb 1923 Bloomfield, Ia.  
In 1864 established his office in Bloomfield, m 4 Mar 1853, A. J. Fenton, a  
native of Columbia, Mo., and they had five ch: Dr. Eberle K. Shelton, Mrs. J. W.  
Caldwell, Dr. Cass Shelton, Dr. Charles Shelton and Miss Maude Shelton. In 1892  
m Amanda Lockman. Buried at IOOF Cemetery at Bloomfield, Ia.
- Swinney, Roscoe Conkling b 4 Oct 1885 at Floris, Ia. d 21 Dec 1897, only child of  
Harvey E. and Laura A. Swinney.
- Warrington, Carrie May d 5 Aug 1903 ae 34yr 4m 6d, dau/o Capt J. A. and Eliza A.  
Warrington of Bloomfield, Ia. She was one of eight children.
- White, May b 13 Oct 1872 Benton Co., Ark. d 27 Jun 1892 Floris, Ia. Moved with  
her parents to Davis Co., Ia. in 1873. Buried Odd Fellows Cemetery in Floris.
