according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the SURVEYOR GENERAL The said warrant having lun ass equid by the said Famuel adams to Daniel Me leavely in whose favor said tracts have been located:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Manuel Me banky, as assigned as a foresaid and to his heurs.
