

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

IDITECAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 57, 329 issued in favor of Rensyman Broker, Private in Captain Jennings Com= hang, Virginia Militia, on Nar of 1812,

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the Easthalf of the Sorth East quarter of Lection twenty four, in Township Minety two Moth, of Range twenty sight Mest, in the Disthick of Lands Rubjech to Lale at Fort Des moines, Lowa, Containing Eighty a cold,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: Which has been a pigned to mues S. Easly;

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said banes of Cashy and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
