Elva Florence Fabian,
daughter of James and Anna
(Hess) Petersen, was born on a
farm in Jackson twp., Shelby
county, on Sept. 2, 1910. She died
at her home in Harlan, on Oct. 31,
1976, at age 66 years, one month
and 29 days. She attended the
Jackson twp. No. 8 country school
and grew to adulthood on her
parent's farm. On Dec. 21, 1932,
she married Waldo C. Mitten at
Omaha, Nebr. After their
marriage, Mr and Mrs Mitten
farmed near Redline. After Mr
Mitten's death in 1955, Elva
moved into Harlan. She worked
for a while at Farner's; then at
Myrtue Memorial hospital; and
later sold Avon products. On Jan.
6, 1968, she married Albert E.
Fabian at the Bethlehem
Lutheran church in Jacksonville
and they made their home at 908
Elm St. in Harlan. After Mr
Fabian's death in 1974, Elva has
continued to make her home in
Harlan. She was baptized and
