

# Ilo Findlay, 86

Ilo Pearl Findlay, daughter of Nevada White and William Dent was born Dec. 19, 1897 at Tologa, Okla. She attended school in Tabor and Kirkman. He received her normal training from Southwest Iowa College in Harlan and later taught rural school for a number of years.

She married Harold Findlay on Oct. 24, 1919 at Harlan. They farmed in Lincoln twp. until 1930 and moved to a farm in Lincoln twp. until their retirement to Harlan in 1963. She was a member of the Congregational United Church of Christ, Lincoln Township social club and the World War I Auxiliary. She died Tuesday, March 27, 1984 at the Baptist Memorial Home where she had resided since Nov. of 1978, at the age of 86 years, 3 months and 27 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband Harold in 1979. Survivors include two sons: Jim of Harlan and Dale of Mo. Valley. She is also survived by nine grandchildren, eight great grandchildren and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Friday, March 30, 1984 at the Congregational United Church of Christ in Harlan with Rev. Dennis Brayman, officiating.
