WALNUT — Henry Frahm was born in Walnut on Sept. 3, 1889, son of Jurgen and Theodora Rethwisch Frahm. He died Monday, Jan. 24, 1977 at St. Joseph's hospital in Omaha at age 87 years, four months and 21 days. On Aug. 19, 1914 he married Margaret Wolf in Co. Bluffs. Four children were born to this union. They lived and farmed in the Walnut community. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran church in Avoca.

He was preceded in death by his parents, four brothers and one sister. Survivors include his wife, Margaret; two sons - LeRoy and Clyde, both of Walnut; two daughters - Mrs Virginia Piittmann and Leona (Mrs Everett) Piittmann, both of Hancock; four grandchildren and three great grandchildren; three brothers - Arthur of Glendora, Calif.; George of Mo. Valley and Albert of Elk Horn.
