Carl, son of Ernest and Lizzie Meyer Frank, was born June 11, 1904 on the family farm in Shelby co. He was baptized on July 8, 1906, in to the Lutheran faith by Rev. A. Engelke. He attended Shelby co. schools through the eighth grade and was graduated from Irwin high school in 1923. He moved with his family in 1927 to a farm south of Manning. He lived and farmed in that area for the rest of his life.

On Aug. 17, 1940, he married Marjorie Moore Frank at Denison. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran church, Lincoln twp., Audubon co., where he was confirmed in 1951 by Rev. William Kanning. He was active in many church affairs, concentrating his efforts on the finance board. He served on the Manning Community hospital assoc. Board of Directors during the time of the organization and building of the new hospital facility. He also served, at one time, as Lincoln twp. Trustee for Audubon co. He died unexpectedly and suddenly at his home on Sunday, March 13, 1983 at the age of 78 years, 9 months and 2 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, three sisters, in infancy, a brother, Herman and a granddaughter, Sandra. Survivors include his wife, Marjorie, one son, Russell and wife Linda of Manning; three grandchildren, Vicki of Spencer, Kim and Rod of Manning; three sisters, Emma (Mrs Louie) Plagman of Harlan, Mamie (Mrs Henry) Plagmann, also of Harlan, Fern (Mrs Wilber) Anthony of Manning; one

brother, Otto Frank, Manning, nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Services were held Friday, March 18, 1983 at the Zion Lutheran church in Manning with Pastor C. Thomas Scher of Trinity Lutheran church officiating. Burial was in the Manning cemetery with Harry Dreier, Ernest Plagman, William Ahrendsen, Ray Christensen, Wade Mohr and Dwain Nordby as casketbearers. Honorary bearers were Harold Asmus, Leslie Greve, Alfred Dammann, Wilber Anthony Robert Dunlap, Robert Moore and Leslie Doyel.
