Earling — Peter Joseph Gaul, the son of Nicholas and Susanna Freidman Gaul was born on a farm near Earling on July 2, 1886. He was the second baby baptized in the new St. Joseph's Catholic parish at Earling. He attended country school and grew to adulthood on the family farm.
