

**THE LIFE STORY OF—
THOMAS E. GAWLEY, 29**

Thomas E. Gawley, son of George and Mary Jane Gawley, was born June 20, 1947 in Carroll. He graduated from Irwin in 1965, then worked as a mechanic. He was a member of the United Methodist Church. In August of 1971 he married Barbara Lytle. To this union two sons were born. He worked for Shelby Co. as a mechanic for the past several years. He died in a car accident south of Denison at age 29 years, 1 month, 18 days. He made many friends through his hobby of race car driving.

Survivors include his parents; two sons - Thomas James and Aaron James, one brother Steve of Irwin; and one sister Mrs Tom (Karen) Stonehouse, Omaha; a grandmother Mrs Johanna Larson, Irwin; nieces and nephews, relatives and friends.
