Elk Horn — Katie Jensen Guy, daughter of Anna Petersen and Lorens Eskov was born Nov. 29, 1890, near Elk Horn. She died at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn at age 90 years, 1 month and 12 days. She was raised and educated near Elk Horn.

On March 18, 1912, she married Antony Jensen. This union was blessed with four children. They farmed in the Elk Horn area for near 40 years before retiring to Harlan in 1950. Following Mr Jensen's death in 1962, she continued to reside in Harlan until 1973, when she moved into the Salem Lutheran Retirement Home.

On Nov. 15, 1977, she married Charles Guy in Elk Horn. Katie was a member of the Elk Horn Lutheran church and Zenobia Rebekah Lodge No. 286 of Harlan.
