

## George Jensen, 80

Kimballton — George Jensen was born on May 1, 1901 in Vive, Denmark. His parents were Peter and Anna Jorgensen Jensen. He was baptized in 1901 in Vive and confirmed in 1915 in Skivholme, Denmark.

He came to the United States from Denmark when he was 19 years old. He came to Kimballton area and worked for Christen Pedersen north and west of town.

On Aug. 11, 1936 he married Rose Pedersen in Papillion, Neb. They continued to farm the Pedersen farm for 52 years, from 1923-1975. She died in July of 1975. He then built a home and moved to Kimballton where he has been for five years. He was currently a member of the Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton.

He died at his home in Kimballton, Wednesday, Sept. 2, 1981. Survivors include three sisters in Denmark. They are Anna Marie Nielsen, Agnus (Mrs Henry) Bruun, and Martha Nielsen. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, Rose, and one sister, Christina Jensen.

Funeral services were held Friday, Sept. 4, 1981 at the Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton with Pastor George Gerber officiating. Burial was in the Immanuel Lutheran cemetery, Kimballton with Charles Larsen, Herbert Larsen, Otis Madsen, Bert Niklasen, Dale Nilkasen and Harold Nielsen serving as casketbearers.
