Elsie Johnson, 69, of Omaha, former Harlan resident, died Friday morning at an Omaha hospital.

Miss Johnson graduated from Harlan high school in 1928. She was a registered nurse, a graduate of Jennie Edmundson Hospital School of Nursing. She was office nurse in Harlan for Dr. E. A. Moore and later for Dr. A. L. Nielsen before becoming Harlan school nurse in 1940. During World War II she enlisted in the U. S. Army and served with the Army Nurse Corps in Germany.

Following the war she moved to Omaha and was office nurse for Dr. Maynard Greenberg for twenty years.

She is survived by a brother, Gerald, of Manning, three nieces, three nephews and several cousins. She was preceded in death by her parents, Mr and Mrs Elmer Johnson, a sister, Cecil; and three brothers, Melvin, Everett and Dale.
