

Lois B. Mallum, 85

Lois Beatrice Mallum, daughter of Levi M. and Ollie E. Snyder Green, was born March 23, 1897 on a farm near Harlan. She attended the country school, growing to adulthood helping on the family farm.

On Feb. 22, 1917, she married Art McConnell. Five children were born to this union. After their marriage, they made their home on a farm near Harlan. After Mr McConnell died in Aug. of 1952, she continued to make her home in Harlan.

On Nov. 25, 1961, she married Sever O. Mallum in Denison. After their marriage, they made their home in Harlan. Mr Mallum died on Dec. 22, 1972. She continued to make her home in Harlan until Oct. of 1981, when she became a resident of the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn.

She was a member of the Congregational Christian United Church of Christ in Harlan and also a member of the V.F.W. Women's Auxiliary of Harlan. She died at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home on Sunday, July 25, 1982, at the age of 85 years.

In addition to her two husbands and parents, she was preceded in death by one son, Vernon on May 7, 1924; two brothers, Dale and Gilbert Green and two sisters, Gladys and Norma. She is survived by two sons, Leland "Cy" McConnell of Irwin and Donald McConnell of Harlan; two daughters, Beulah (Mrs Fred) Moore of Des Moines and Jenell McKenzie of Cheyenne, Wyo.; one step daughter, Elaine (Mrs Lynn) Gearhart of Harlan; 13 grandchildren and six great grandchildren; one brother, Everett Green of White River, S.D.; two sisters, Vera (Mrs Chester) Lindquist of Hamilton, Mont. and Leota Shouldis of White River, S.D.; nieces, nephews and other relatives and many friends.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Wednesday, July 28, 1982 with Rev. Wayne Selsor, Interim Pastor of the Congregational Christian United Church of Christ in Harlan, officiating.

Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Kevin McConnell, Gary McConnell, Shawn McConnell, Mark Larson, Orville Moore and Joe Kaminskis serving as casketbearers.
