

The Life Story Of — **Edna H. Marshall, 77**

Walnut — Edna H. Marshall was born Dec. 1, 1903 in Walnut, daughter of Carsten and Christine Johannsen Hansen. She was a 1922 graduate of the Walnut high school and then attended Iowa State Teachers College in Cedar Falls. She moved to Long Beach, Calif., in 1930 where she became a legal secretary.

She married Joseph Marshall in 1936 in Long Beach, and continued as a legal secretary until her retirement. Her husband died in 1959, and in Oct. 1979, she moved to Peace Haven Home in Walnut. Mrs. Marshall had been a patient at Cass County hospital for several weeks before being transferred to Clarkson hospital, Omaha, where she died Monday, Jan. 12, 1981 at age 77 years.

Surviving are two brothers, Henry O. Hansen and George B. Hansen of Walnut; a sister, Mrs. Willinda Hogan of Omaha; several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, and one sister, Wilma.

Funeral services were held at the Berthusen-Knutson Funeral Home in Walnut on Thursday, Jan. 15, 1981 with Orris Drake, officiating. Burial was Jan. 16 at Sunnyside Memorial Park cemetery in Long Beach, Calif.

Mrs. Marshall's sister, Mrs. Willinda Hogan, and nephew, Roy Hogan, accompanied the body to Long Beach, and attended the service there at the graveside.
