

THE LIFE STORY OF- HATTIE MCGEE, 80

Hattie Lenore McGee, daughter of Hannah Slates and Aaron D. Ames was born Jan. 19, 1896 at Kirkman. She died April 2, 1976 at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn, at age 80 years, 2 months and 13 days. Hattie was educated in the Kirkman school. She married Warren McGee Aug. 22, 1917 at Kirkman, and to this union one son was born. They farmed in the Kirkman area until 1940 when they moved near Tennant, here they continued to farm until 1946 when they retired to Tennant. Mrs McGee has been a life long member of the Kirkman and then the Tennant Methodist church.

Mrs McGee was preceded in death by her parents, two brothers- Edward H. and Roy Ames and by one sister- Mrs Pearl Ferry. Survivors include her husband- Warren of Elk Horn, one son- Owen of Tennant, five grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Monday, April 5, 1976, at Burmeister Funeral Home with Pastor Dick Krambeck of the Tennant Methodist church, officiating. Burial was in the Rose Hill Cemetery, Kirkman, with Leslie Linn, Harold Havick, Richard Miller, Myron Sorensen, Clarence McKnabb and Lawrence Kolterman serving as casket-bearers.
