

Florence Grace McIntyre, 96

Florence Grace McIntyre, daughter of Francis and Grace McKinnon Plumb was born Sept. 21, 1885 near Harlan. Both her parents came to America from England in 1868. She was raised on the family farm.

She married Harry W. McIntyre in 1908. They had one son, Francis Edgar. They moved to San Jose, Calif., where they resided until the death of Mr. McIntyre in 1961. She was a member of the First United Methodist church in San Jose, and served terms as President of the Women's Society of Christian Service for the home church and for the San Jose District. In 1934 she served a term as Matron of the Santa Clara Chapter of the Order of Eastern Star.

She died at the Santa Clara nursing facility on Saturday, Oct. 17 at the age of 96.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her son, Francis, and her husband. Survivors include her daughter-in-law Frances in Ariz.; two grandsons and five great grandchildren. Harlan area survivors include, Max Plumb, Mrs Harold Havick, Carrie Petersen, Andrew Sorensen, Mrs Francis Goodner, Lyle Plumb and Harold Plumb.
