Dorothy Ohlinger was born Dorothy Elizabeth Meisner on August 9, 1916, Sabetha, Kansas. She passed away at Omaha's St. Joseph's Hospital on April 11, 1985. She was preceded in death by her sister and close companion Helen Sohn and by husband Ed Howe and second husband Ike Ohlinger.
