

1983 Lawrence N. Ohlinger, 66

Lawrence Nicholas Ohlinger, son of Michael J. and Clara Schomer Ohlinger was born Dec. 5, 1916, on a farm southwest of Panama. He was baptized, received his First Communion and confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic church in Panama. He attended St. Mary's Catholic school in Panama and graduated from the 12th grade in 1936.

After school he helped on the family farm and worked as a hired hand for a few years. On Oct. 7, 1940 he married Pauline Huebner at St. Mary's Catholic church in Portsmouth. Six children were born to this union. After marriage they farmed for two years near Panama and then moved to a farm southwest of Portsmouth. This is where they farmed until Feb. of 1979, when he retired and they moved to Harlan. This has been their home since that time.

He was a member of St. Michael's Catholic church in Harlan. He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Feb. 16, 1983 at the age of 66 years, 2 months and 11 days.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by one son Ronald and one brother Harold. He is survived by his wife Pauline of Harlan; two daughters Janice (Mrs Rick) McCoy of Osceola and Diane Ohlinger of Co. Bluffs; three sons, Darrell of Vallejo, Calif., Kenneth of Co. Bluffs and Larry of Harlan; three sisters, Kathryn (Mrs Robert) Huebner of Persia; Madeline Ohlinger of Oceanside, Calif. and Gladys (Mrs Gerald) Andersen of Harlan; one brother, Jacob of Harlan, four grandchildren and three step-grandchildren, nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Feb. 19, 1983 at St. Michael's Catholic church in Harlan with the Rev. David Polich as celebrant and the Rev. Richard Wagner as con-celebrant.

Burial was in the St. Mary's cemetery, Portsmouth, with Marty Huebner, Mike Andersen, Dave Andersen, Wayne Huebner, Joseph Huebner and Bud Chamberlain serving as casketbearers.
