

Leslie Outhouse

Leslie David Outhouse, son of David and Inez Sherer Outhouse was born May 16, 1898 near Moorehead. Leslie had been baptised in the R.L.D.S. church at Moorehead, and has been a lifelong member. He lived and attended school in the rural Moorehead area all of his boyhood years. He married Gladys M. Nuzum on Aug. 22, 1922. To this union five were born, Delora, Dorothy, Donna, Doris and David. The family lived in the Moorehead area and later in the Soldier area. In 1953 Leslie moved to Defiance and Denison area and remained in this area until 1971, when he left the farm to live alternately with daughters, Dorothy and Donna. He died Sept. 12, 1976 after spending a brief time in a nursing home in Vermillion, So. Dakota.
