



THE LIFE STORY OF —

Steve Parr

Steven Wayne Parr, son of Lawrence R. and Jeannine Phipps Parr, was born in Oceanside, Calif., on Dec. 18, 1952. He moved with his parents to Dallas Center, in 1953. A few years later they moved to Boone, where Steve started school. The family moved to Harlan in 1968 where he completed his education, graduating from the Harlan Community high school in 1971. He served in the Army for two years and attended the University of Iowa City. He was currently employed as a lineman for the Mid America Pipe Line Co. Steve died at Mercy hospital in Iowa City, on Febr. 10, 1977 at age 24 years, one month and 22 days.

He was preceded in death by his grandfather, Otto Parr and by his grandmother, Mrs Wayne Phipps. His survivors include his parents, Mr and Mrs Larry Parr of Ankeny, two sisters - Diane (Mrs Lyle Fiscus) of Coralville and Janet Parr at home; his grandmother, Mrs Otto Parr of Sac City; his grandfather, Wayne Phipps of Shenandoah and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Monday, Febr. 14, 1977, with Rev. Larry LaVelle, pastor of the First United Methodist church in Harlan, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan Cemetery, with Dave Olsen, Tim Leinen, Dan Arkfeld, Lyle Fiscus, Mike Donlin, and Roger Phipps serving as casketbearers.
