**PORTSMOUTH** — Theodore Pauley, son of Peter and Clara Thielen Pauley, was born on a farm in Shelby county, on Febr. 2, 1900. He died at St. Joseph - Creighton Memorial hospital in Omaha, Nebr. on Sept. 17, 1977 at age 77 years, 7 months and 15 days. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Boniface church in Westphalia. He attended country school and grew to adulthood on his parent's farm. On June 9, 1926, he married Rose Pitsch at St. Mary's church in Portsmouth. Nine children were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Pauley farmed near

Portsmouth and this has been his home since that time. Ted was a life time Shelby county resident and had farmed his entire adult life. Since their marriage, he had been a member of St. Mary's church in Portsmouth. He was a member of the Earling Council No. 1741, Knights of Columbus.
