Daniel Petersen, the son of Erik and Barolene (Morgensen) Petersen, was born on April 5, 1898 on a farm near Poplar in Audubon Co. He died at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn on Saturday, Aug. 24, 1985, at age 87 years, 4 months and 19 days.

He attended country school and grew to adulthood on his parents farm. On Oct. 17, 1917, he married Jessie Evangeline Petersen at her mothers home in Exira. Five children were born to this union.
