Nick Petersen, son of Nels and Nettas Andersen Petersen, was born April 7, 1898 in Pine Bluffs, Wyoming. He dies at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan May 19, 1972, at the age of 74 years, I month and 12 days. The cause of death was a heart disease.

He was baptized and confirmed in the Danish Lutheran church. As a youth, Nick and his brothers were placed in the Elim Home Orphanage in Elk Horn and stayed there until beginning work at the Thomas Christensen home. He was a farmer for 28 years in the area east of Elk Horn and also farmed for 15 years
