Mrs Lehman Pinckney, 59

Forest City — Darlene Pinckney, daughter of Elliott and Zella Terril, was born Oct. 5, 1920 in Harlan. She received her education in the Harlan schools. She was a secretary in the former Iowa Liquor Control Commission offices in Des Moines.

She married Lehman Pinckney, March 25, 1950. They lived in Forest City, where he operated the Pinckney Drug Store. She died at her home in Forest City on Wednesday, Nov. 21, 1979 at age 59 years.

She was preceded in death by her father, a brother and sister.
