



## Margaret M. Pleasants, 95

Harlan — Margaret May Pleasants, daughter of William H. and Samantha Cornelia Reeves Robinson, was born in Bristow, Va., on Febr. 26, 1883. She lived with her parents in Bristow, until the age of 5. They then moved to Alexandria, Va., where she attended school and grew to adulthood.

On Feb. 26, 1900, she married Richard H. Pleasants at Washington, D.C. Four daughters were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Pleasants made their home in Alexandria, Va. After her husband's death in 1941, Margaret made her home with her children until moving to Harlan in 1963. This was her home until becoming a resident of the Little Flower Haven in Earling in 1971.

Mrs Pleasants died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan, Saturday, Nov. 4, 1978, at age 95 years, 8 months and 8 days.

In addition to her parents and her husband, Mrs Pleasants was preceded in death by three daughters — Fannie M. McDonough, Little C. Bryan, and Marie V. More. She is survived by a daughter, Hattie L. Sutherland of Atlanta, Ga., a sister, Lucy M. Connelly of Annandale, Va., nine grandchildren; 23 great-grandchildren; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at the Cunningham Funeral Home in Alexandria, Va., on Tuesday, Nov. 7, 1978, with Rev. Dr. Mark Anschutz, officiating.
