

MRS JOSEPH REISCHL, 75

PANAMA— Mrs Pauline Reischl,

daughter of Rosa and Vincent Schenk, was born Aug. 18, 1898 in Schluenberg, Tex. She grew to adulthood in this community and in 1919 she moved to Westphalia. She died on July 1, 1974 at Mercy hospital in Co. Bluffs, at age 75 years, 10 months, 13 days. On April 13, 1920 she married Joseph Reischl at St. Boniface church in Westphalia. Seven children were born to this union. After living in Westphalia for a year Mr and Mrs Reischl moved to Defiance, in 1921. While in this community, she was a member of St. Peter's church and St. Peter's Altar Society. Mrs Reischl continued to live in Defiance after Mr Reischl's death on Mar. 11, 1958. In 1964 she moved to Woodbine, to become housekeeper for her son, Rev. Fred P. Reischl. In 1969 when Father Reischl was appointed pastor of St. Mary's church in Panama, she moved with him to this community. At the time of her death she was a member of St. Mary's church in Panama and she had continued her membership in St. Peter's Altar Society in Defiance.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by three sisters, Minnie (Mrs Jacob Bauer), Mary (Mrs Paul Sazuma), and Annie (Mrs Ray Anderka); by two brothers - Edward and Adolph Schenk; and by three grandchildren, Linda Reischl, Charles Kleffman, and Danny Weis.

She is survived by three daughters - Mary Ann (Mrs LeRoy Stephenson) of Lake City, Ia., Cecilia (Mrs Harry Kleffman) of Port-

smouth; and Leona (Mrs Eugene Weis) of Earling; and by four sons - Joseph J. Reischl of Earling, Edwin J. Reischl of Manning, Rev. Fred P. Reischl of Panama; and Norbert L. Reischl of Omaha, Nebr.; by 31 grandchildren and four great grandchildren; by one sister - Rose (Mrs George Schwartz) of Cuero, Tex. by her nieces and nephews, and other relatives.

A Concelebrated Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated on Thursday, July 4, 1974 at St. Peter's church in Defiance with her son Rev. Fred P. Reischl as celebrant, the concelebrants were: Rev.
