

Clifford P. Rold, 78

Clifford Peter Rold, son of Samuel and Anna Kate Johnson Rold, was born May 17, 1903 east of Harlan in Shelby co. He attended the country school near Rabbit Hollow and grew to adulthood on the family farm.

As a young man, he moved to Harlan where he was employed by the county and then became a mechanic for International Harvester in Harlan. He worked in this capacity for 52 years, retiring in 1980. He was also employed by Orv Rocker Ford as a driver for many years. He was a member of the First Baptist church here in Harlan for many years. He died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan on Saturday, Aug. 8, 1981, at the age of 78 years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters, Luella and Lucy and one brother, Leonard. He is survived by two sisters, Mildred Christianson of Harlan and Lottie (Mrs Oscar) Jensen of Ankeny, and one brother, Harold O. Rold of Harlan. He is also survived by his nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Monday, Aug. 10, 1981 with Pastor C. Donald Thrash of the First Baptist church officiating.
