Adeline Marie Rosmann, daughter of Joseph and Rose Hodapp Rosmann, was born September 27, 1909 on a farm in Lincoln Township near Westphalia, Iowa. She died at St Joseph's hospital in Omaha, Neb., August 21, 1972 at the age of 62 years, 10 months, and 24 days. Miss Rosmann attended St. Boniface school and grew to adulthood on her parents farm in Lincoln Township. In the spring of 1947 she moved into Westphalia, where she helped care for her parents. After the death of her mother in October, 1967, she became housekeeper for Fr. Adam S. Reisz and in 1969, she moved to Dunlap and continued in this capacity. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Boniface church in Westphalia. She

was a member of this church until she moved to Dunlap, where she became a member of St. Patrick's church. She also belonged to St. Patrick's Altar Society.

She was preceded in death by her parents and one brother, Walter Rosmann.

Surviving are: her sister, Sister Mary Louis, O.S.F. of Milwaukee, Wisc.; two brothers, Ray and Leonard Rosmann of Westphalia; seven nieces and nephews; two grandnieces and two grandnephews.

A Con-Celebrated Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated Thursday, August 24, 1972, at St. Boniface church in Westphalia with Rev Adam S. Reisz as Celebrant. Rev Arthur L. McCann, the Very Rev Msgr Albert L. Davidsaver, and Rev Wayne Gubbels were the Con-Celebrants.

Burial was at St. Boniface cemetery in Westphalia with Ralph Hodapp, Leo Hodapp, Virgil Hodapp, Jack Kirschbaum, Ulrich Rosman and Elmer Hennes serving as casket bearers.
