Funeral services were held Tuesday at Harlan St. Michael's Catholic Church for Raymond J. Rosmann, 72, Harlan. Burial was in Westphalia St. Boniface Cemetery.

Rosmann, a former Westphalia resident, died Sat., May 10 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital, Harlan. He was a longtime member of Westphalia St. Boniface Catholic Church and sang in the choir there for 40 years.
