

Leonard C. Rossman, 78

Walnut — Leonard C. Rossman, was born in 1902 in Walnut, son of Christian and Caroline Nissen Rossman.

He married Margaret Irene Connors in Ames on June 8, 1930. They lived in Perry all their married life. During WWII he worked as an extra for the Milwaukee Railroad.

He belonged to the National Education Assn., the Iowa State Education Assn. and the Perry Education Assn. He came to Perry in 1929 and taught many years at the Perry high school. Rossman retired from teaching in 1967. He was high school publications advisor for many years and past president of the Iowa High School Press Assn. He died Friday, May 8, 1981 at his home in Perry at age 78 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one daughter, two brothers and four sisters. Survivors include his wife; three brothers, George of Galt, Calif., Arthur of Harley and Walter of Manchester; one sister, Mrs Evelyn Petersen of Walnut and nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held at Fouch Funeral Home in Perry with Rev. Leon Lebuda of the First Presbyterian church of Perry officiating. Burial was in Violet Hill cemetery in Perry with Pat Taylor, John Turner, Clifford Peters, Merle Grubbs, Harold Gamble and Merrill Edwards serving as casketbearers.
