## Norma Ruby, 80

Norma Louisa Ruby, daughter of Maren Ebbesen and Adolph D. Reyelt was born Oct. 9, 1901 at Harlan. She died Thursday, Dec. 10, 1981 at the Jennie Edmundson hospital in Co. Bluffs at the age of 80 years. She graduated from the Harlan high school and the Drake Univ. in Des Moines. She taught school in Tabor and Winterset.

In 1921, she married Harlan Hunter Ruby in Cedar Rapids. Following her husband's death in 1931, she returned to Harlan. She also taught school in Elk Horn, Audubon, and Harlan for a number of years until her retirement.

She was a life long member of the St. Paul's Episcopal church of Harlan and the Altar Guild, member of the American Legion Auxiliary, Delphian Society, Shelby County Historical society and the Myrtue Memorial hospital Auxiliary.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Harlan, two brothers, Alfred and Helmer and one sister, Dana Friend. Survivors include her daughter, Mrs Joanne Ouren of Harlan, four grandchildren, four great grandchildren, one sister, Olga Reyelt of Harlan and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Dec. 12, 1981 at the St. Paul's Episcopal church with Father Glenn Rankin officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Tom Ouren, Greg Ouren, Jim Friend, Stan Heese, Grant McMartin and Dr. Joseph H. Spearing serving as pallbearers.
