MARVIN RUHS, 64

IRWIN — Marvin Ruhs, son of Fred and Lottie Paydon Ruhs, was born on Dec. 3, 1909 at Botna. He graduated from the Irwin school in 1927 and worked in the elevator in Irwin and Kirkman for his father. He married Ruby Vermuel of Manilla on May 1, 1933. This union was blessed with two children. Marvin lived in Irwin several years, then moved to Denver, Colo., where he died May 3, 1974 at age 64 years.

He was preceded in death by his mother in 1918 and his father and step mother, one sister Fern (Mrs Russell Paulsen). Survivors include one son - Fred Ruhs of Grand Junction, Colo., a daughter - Mary (Mrs Hartsook) of Wheatridge, Colo., two grandchildren all in Colorado, by four sisters Mrs Ray (Mildred) Fogarty of Phoenix, Ariz., Mrs Russell (Hazel) Croft of Kirkman, Mrs Mervyn (Loa) Reuber of Ontario, Canada, Mrs Jack (Arline) King of Tucson, Ariz., and one half sister - Mrs Brian (Caryl) Clark in Calif., nieces, nephews and other relatives.
