MANNING – Henry, son of Gustav and Mary Karsten Vinke was born Oct. 31, 1900 near Manning. He attended rural school in that area. He was confirmed on March 29, 1944 and became a member of Zion Lutheran Church. On Feb. 25, 1925, he married Malinda Walter in Denison. They farmed northwest of Manning where they lived for 26 years. In 1951, they purchased a home in Manning where they lived for 29 years. In May of 1980 they sold their home and moved to the Terrace Apartments. He worked for Dultmeier Lumber Co., and at the VFW Hall. Malinda died on Aug. 5, 1985.

He became a resident of the Manning Plaza in July of 1989 and died there on Aug. 9, 1989 at age 88 years, 9 months and 9 days.
