

Rosetta Walters, 82

Harlan — Rosetta Walters, daughter of Effie DeWitt Kees and Wayne Davison was born Jan. 1, 1897 at Pilger, Nebr. She died Sunday, Sept. 16, 1979 at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at age 82 years, 8 months and 15 days.

Rosetta attended school in Minden, Nebr., and Harlan. She married Dwight Copeland in 1919. Two sons were born to this union. She has been a resident of Harlan since 1930, except while she worked at the Nebraska Ordinance Plant at Mead, Nebr.

In 1946 she married Art Conrad and in 1967 she married Earl Walters. Rosetta was a telephone operator and housekeeper for many years, a member of the Harlan First United Methodist church, Harlan V.F.W. Auxiliary and the Hospital Auxiliary.

Mrs Walters was preceded in death by her parents, three husbands - Dwight Copeland, Art Conrad and Earl Walters and one stepson - Kenneth Walters.
