IRWIN — Carl Frederick Wiese was born Mar. 13, 1902 near Marne. At the age of 16 years he came to the Irwin community where he worked on various farms. He married Leona Andresen on June 26, 1929. They have lived near Irwin until 1962 when they moved into town. Carl farmed and operated a truck. After moving to town he was custodian of Ruhs Park and for the Senior Citizens home in Irwin. He was active in the Senior Citizens club activities. After spending a week in the Harlan hospital, Carl returned to his home this last Saturday where he died in his sleep early Sunday morning, Febr. 20, 1977 at age 74 years, 11 months and seven days.

He was preceded in death by his mother and step father and by one step brother, Ed Kuchel. Survivors include his wife, Leona, three children, Lyla (Mrs Allan) Thompson of Irwin, Ladelle (Mrs Orlando) Hansen of Manilla and Allan Wiese of Manning, nine grandchildren, three great grandchildren, one step-sister, Mrs Alvina Andresen of Irwin, three step brothers, Bill Kuchel, Arcata, Calif., Albert Kuchel of Manning and Harold Kuchel of Walnut and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Febr. 23, 1977, at Ohde Funeral home in Manilla with Rev. J. Elmer Brunk of the United Methodist church of Irwin officiating. Burial was in Oak Hill cemetery in Irwin with Roger Wiese, Craig Thompson, Danny Thompson, Jim Bexten, Sonny Goans and Howard Kuchel serving as casketbearers.
