## Mrs. Elsie Williams, 84

LINCOLN, NEBR. — Mrs. Elsie Williams, wife of former Harlan United Methodist Church minister, the Rev. Allan Williams, died July 11. A Lincoln resident at the time of death, Mrs. Williams was 84.

Her husband served the Harlan United Methodist Church from 1964-'70, before Rev. and Mrs. Williams moved to Lincoln. The Rev. Allan K. Williams died in 1976.

Funeral services for Mrs. Williams were held July 15 at Roper & Sons Chapel in Lincoln, with burial in the Wyuka Cemetery in Lincoln.

Survivors include one son, Raymond D. of Omaha; four brothers — David Eichelberger of Prairie Village, Kan., Kenneth D., of Farmington, N. M., and Theodore C. and Russell E., both of Lincoln; one sister, Mrs. Harley Arnetta-Giles of Lincoln; and one grandson.

The Rev. Everett Burham succeeded the Rev. Williams at the Harlan church from 1970-'71, and the Rev. John Wallace served from 1971-'73 before the church's current minister, the Rev. Larry LaVelle, and his family came to Harlan.
