

Charlotte G. Winder, 78

Charlotte Gould Winder, daughter of John P. and Ada Thomas Gould, was born Nov. 7, 1904 in Harlan. She attended school, graduating from Harlan high school in 1922. She then attended the University of Iowa at Iowa City, graduating with a teaching degree and then taught school for several years.

In 1977, Charlotte married Dr. C.D. Winder of Waterloo. Four children were born to this union. After their marriage, Dr. and Mrs Winder made their home in Eugene, Oreg., for a short time while he was in the service. From 1935 to 1939, they made their home in Harlan, where Dr. Winder had his own medical practice. They moved to Waterloo, in 1939, where Dr. Winder continued his medical practice for many years. After retiring, the Winders have made their home in Waterloo during the summer and Mesa, Ariz., during the winter.

Mrs Winder was a very active member of the United Methodist church first in Harlan and then in Waterloo. She was also a member of the Eastern Star, Lebanon Chapter No. 8, O.E.S. of Harlan.

She died in Mesa, Ariz. on Dec. 20, 1982, having attained the age of 78 years, 1 month and 3 days.

In addition to her parents, Charlotte was preceded in death by one sister, Alice Kirk. She is survived by her husband, Dr. Winder of Mesa, Ariz.; three sons, John of Waterloo, Tom of Houston, Texas and Richard of Iowa Falls; one daughter, Carol Winder of Jackson, Wyo.; eight grandchildren; one brother, Russell Gould of Harlan;

one sister, Esther (Mrs Albert) Vogel of San José, Calif.; nieces and nephews; other relatives and a great many friends.

Funeral services were held in Mesa, Ariz. on Wednesday, Dec. 15, 1982.

Burial will be in Waterloo at a later date.
