exit ramp dies from hit and run injuries

SHELBY -- A man who was found unconscious and critically injured early Wednesday, July 6 on the westbound off-ramp of Interstate 80 near Shelby has died.

Mosadaq Aden, 31, of St. Paul, Minn., had been walking on Interstate 80 a little after 3 a.m. According to the Iowa State Patrol crash report, Aden was wearing dark clothing making him difficult to see, and an unknown vehicle struck him.

Aden was taken by helicopter to the Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha, but sustained severe head and body injuries which caused his death.

The vehicle that struck Aden has not been identified.

Aden had gone to Las Vegas and was bound for his hometown of St. Paul by whatever transportation was immediately available. The incident was being investigated as a hit-and-run accident.
