John Stinn taught him during a parish mission at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama around 1965.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife Nora, by a daughter Mary Ann, five brothers, Joseph, Peter, Mike, Ben and John, eight sisters, Kate, Anna, Sr. Margaret, Sr. Antilia, Clara, Sophie, Lena, Mary and two infants. He is survived by four sons, Vernon Blum of Harlan, Chris Jr. (Pat) Blum of Portsmouth, Charles Blum of Panama, and Emil Blum of Omaha, NE, six daughters, Virginia (Louis) Wingert of Panama, Sr. Joyce Blum of F.S.P.A. of Tucson, AZ, Alice (Jerry) Zimmerman of Minden, Jean (LeRoy) Heese of Defiance, Judy (Fred) Clark of Omaha, and Audrey (Dennis) Smith of Plattsmouth, NE, 33 grandchildren, 33 great grandchildren, nieces, nephews and other relatives.
