HARLAN – Victor Carl Brodersen, son of Charley and Karen Hansen Brodersen was born March 9, 1906 near Kirkman. He was raised in Harlan and attended Harlan High School. During WW II, he served with the U.S. Navy in the Mediterranean Sea.

June 6, 1953, he married Margaret Davis Ingwers at Harlan. They lived in Spencer and Sioux City, while he was a mechanic with Herman Brown Co. In 1955, they moved to his parents farm northeast of Kimballton and later moved to Harlan in 1977. He died April 4, 1990 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan age 84 years and 25 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents. Survivors include his wife, Margaret of Harlan; two step sons, Freddie Ingwers of Aurora, CO. and Norman Ingwers of Kimballton; step-daughter, Lois Petersen of Bellevue, NE.; sister, Bernice Skow of Emmetsburg and six step-grandchildren; by a nephew and a niece; an uncle, Almer Hansen of Harlan and other relatives.

Funeral services were held April 6, 1990 at Burmeister Funeral Home with Rev. Oliver S. Solberg, officiating. Burial was in the Jacksonville cemetery with Leonard Kay, Ronald Davis, Robert Davis, Robert Becker, Ronald Boysen and Merrill Martin as casketbearers.
