Leon (Pork) Bubke, 54 July 17, 1952 - Oct. 12, 2006

DENISON — Leon Theodore (Pork) Bubke was born July 17, 1952, son of Irvin and Edyth Bubke, in Battle Creek and was baptized and confirmed at St. John's Lutheran Church in Battle Creek. He received his education in Schleswig where he graduated in 1970. He then went to the Peace Corp from 1976 to 1978 when he volunteered his agricultural knowledge in Malaysia. Upon returning to the United States, he attended lowa Lakes Community College and obtained an Associate's degree in agricultural management in 1986.

Pork married Colleen Mencke in August of 2001 where they made their home in Denison. He died Oct. 12, 2006, while working in Davis, CA, at age 54.

Pork was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, Mike Bubke and David Schulte; one sister, Pam King; and a nephew, Jamey Schulte.
