HARLAN — John Monroe Buckner, son of Dennis and Laura (Mishler) Buckner, was born June 6, 1918, in rural Audubon County. While growing up, he attended school in Gray, and rural Guthrie County. After his schooling, he entered the United States Army where he served his country honorably overseas during World War II.
