Adeline Caddell, 98 June 18, 1917 - Nov. 3, 2015 HARLAN — Adeline Ann Caddell was born on June 18, 1917 to John and Mary (Behrendt) Hein in Portsmouth. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church and attended the Catholic school through the eighth grade when she left to help work on the family farm.

Adeline married Archie Caddell on January 26, 1937 in Portsmouth and this union was blessed with three children: Bonita, Robert, and Marlene. After their marriage, they farmed, raised hogs, and owned a dance



hall in Portsmouth. They lived in Westphalia while her husband established his painting business before moving to Harlan.

Adeline's work life was long and varied and included time at a grocery store, in the laundry department at the hospital until she arrived at Concerned, Inc. until her retirement in 1975. She enjoyed gardening, cooking and baking for her family. She is remembered for a brutally honest, yet great sense of humor; being proud for being a smallpox survivor; and having had the opportunity to hold each of her twenty-two great-great grandchildren. Adeline died Tuesday, November 3, 2015 at Salem Lutheran Home in Elk Horn, having attained the age of ninety-eight years, four months and sixteen days.

Adeline was preceded in death by her parents; her husband Archie in 2009; brothers: Henry, Joseph, John, George, and Edward Hein; and sisters Clara Foxhoven, Mary Pitsch, and Lucina Pitsch. She is survived by her children: Bonita Rasmussen of Harlan, Robert Caddell and his wife, Regina of Vail, and Marlene and her husband Gary Doyel of Humboldt; eight grandchildren; twenty-seven greatgrandchildren; twenty-two great-great grandchildren; other family members and friends.
