

Kimballton man reported missing

KIMBALLTON -- Authorities are searching for a 70-year-old Kimballton man reported missing last Saturday after he failed to return home as scheduled.

Donald Clark has been entered into the computer database as a missing person.

Family members and law enforcement from the Audubon County Sheriff's Office, Shelby County Sheriff's Office and Iowa Highway Patrol have been searching for him after he didn't come home from a local establishment in Kimballton Saturday evening.

"We spent all day yesterday looking for him," said Shelby County Sheriff Gene Cavanaugh. "We drove all the roads and had

the highway patrol plane up in the air searching."

Clark was apparently on his way home Saturday, March 24 from Arnold's Bar in Kimballton, and he lives only a few blocks away.

He was supposed to be home at 6:30 p.m. but never arrived, officials said.

"He left the bar at 6:30 p.m. Saturday night and hasn't been seen since," said Cavanaugh.

Audubon County Chief Deputy

Jake Matthews said Clark, a longtime Shelby County and Audubon County-area resident, spoke with his wife on the phone only a few minutes prior to leaving the bar.

"He told her he was going home," said Matthews. "He just never arrived.

"The family has said this is just not like him."

Authorities have searched area hospitals to see if he had been involved in some type of accident. Officials said he does require asthma medication, and has an inhaler with him.

Clark is driving a 1992 Dodge Dakota extended cab, blue and silver, with Iowa license plate 122-ABQ.
