Closson, daughter of Albert and Bernice (Sunderland) Larsen, was born on May 2, 1930, in Kirkman. She was baptized and a member of the First United Methodist Church in Harlan and graduated from the Harlan High School.

June 18, 1948, she was united in marriage to Leroy Closson. After their wedding, they resided in Harlan. MaeVerlee worked as a waitress for Holiday Buffet and Red Lion. She was a member of the VFW Post No. 941 Ladies Auxiliary and enjoyed cooking, baking, and sewing. After retiring in 1984, MaeVerlee and Leroy moved to Kerrville, TX, where MaeVerlee con-

tinued to live until 2006. She then lived for a short time in Arkansas, Kansas, and Oklahoma. MaeVerlee died on Monday, November 23, 2009, at Eufaula Nursing Home in Eufaula, OK, having attained the age of seventy-nine years, six months, and twenty-one days.
