Barb was a past 4-H leader for the Monroe Merry Makers 4-H Club, and was a member of the Knitter's Club that would meet at Mickel's Family Restaurant in Harlan. Shortly after she was married, Barb and her high school classmates formed a sewing club which still continues to meet with the second and third generation families. Barb died on Saturday, December 26, 2009, at her home having attained the age of eighty-three years, five months, and seventeen days.

Barb is preceded in death by her parents; her son, Hunter; and her brother Marvin.
