

Bernice Feser, 78 April 23, 1928 - March 22, 2007

HARLAN - Bernice Schulte Feser was born April 23, 1928, to William and Anna Schulte of Earling. After completing high school, she became a nanny and took care of the children of Dr. Stoner in Omaha, NE. Later she worked at a sweet corn factory in Harlan.

Bernice was diagnosed with leukemia Feb. 14, 2007, admitted to Alegent Health Mercy Hospital Feb. 19, 2007, and it was there that she died March 22, 2007, at age seventy-eight years, ten months, and twenty-seven days.

Bernice was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Leo, her son Leslie, her brothers Lawrence, John, Raymond, and Howard, and her sisters Frances Irwin, Ellen Stoll, and Helen Carey.
