EARLING — Anthony "Tony" Vitus Gaul, the son of William and Catherine (Schechinger) Gaul, was born Nov. 28, 1920, on a farm near Earling. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling. He attended school at St. Joseph's in Earling. Tony farmed with his parents and later by himself, retiring in 1986. Tony died suddenly Dec. 17, 2004, on the farm that he loved and spent all of his life taking care of, at age 84 years and 19 days.
