Her main enjoyment was spending time with her grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and all children she met and especially liked playing card games with them. After Ed's death in 2005, Sylvia remained in their home until her death on Friday, March 21, 2014. She had attained the age of ninety-one years, four months, and six days.
