HARLAN — Lorena Catherine Gubbels was born on June 24, 1917 to Nick and Christena (Muell) Mickels on a farm near Panama. Lorena moved to Elm Crest Retirement Home in 2005, where she died on Saturday, October 4, 2014, having attained the age of ninety-seven years, three months, and ten days.
